system, as outlined under the **National Education Policy** (**NEP**) **2020**, to promote academic flexibility and lifelong learning. Dr. B. Amudhambigai, Associate Professor, PG & Research Department of Mathematics, Sri Sarada College for Women, Salem – 16 acted as a resource person and delivered a comprehensive lecture on the ABC system's policy framework, implementation strategies, and integration with the **National Academic Depository** (**NAD**) and **DigiLocker**. A practical demonstration was conducted on how to register faculty and students on the ABC portal, manage credits, and align institutional curricula with ABC norms. The workshop concluded with an engaging Q&A session, allowing faculty members to clarify their doubts regarding credit mapping, program design, and assessment. The workshop received active participation from faculty members across various departments. Participants gained valuable insights into the systematic adoption of ABC and expressed readiness to support its implementation in their respective institutions.



AN ONLINE CONSULTATIVE WORKSHOP ON "NAAC - REFORMS 2024 BINARY ACCREDITATION FRAMEWORK"

An online consultative workshop on "NAAC - Reforms 2024: Binary Accreditation Framework" was conducted on 27.09.2024 for faculty members by IQAC. The workshop aimed to create awareness and understanding of the recent changes introduced by NAAC under the new Binary Accreditation model, focusing on outcome-based quality assessment and simplified processes. A detailed presentation was delivered by Dr.G.Tholkappia Arasu, Chief Executive Officer, Aassaan Accreditation Pvt. Ltd. Charter President, Rotary Club of Global Scholars He has explained rationale behind the shift to binary accreditation, revised indicators and data validation mechanisms. Further he has emphasised on Student Learning outcomes, Institutional Effectiveness, and Stakeholder Satisfaction. Participants shared their views and challenges in adapting to the new framework. Constructive discussions were held on improving documentation, aligning IQAC practices, and strengthening data systems and the attribute heads and IQAC Members actively participated, contributing valuable insights to the consultation process and clarified their doubts.



HANDS ON TRAINING ON MS TEAMS FOR MICROSOFT DIGITAL CLASSROOM DEPLOYMENT

A hands-on training session on Microsoft Teams was conducted on 07.10.2024 organised by IQAC to facilitate the effective deployment and use of the Microsoft Digital Classroom platform. The training was specifically designed for faculty members to enhance their digital teaching skills and ensure seamless integration of MS Teams into daily academic activities.
