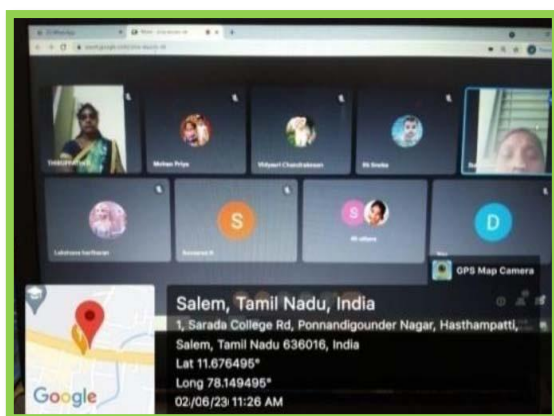
01.01.2024 to 31.01.2024
