


### **Objectives of Feedback**

To give students the offhand to remark on the quality of their learning experience, as part of the preparation for and evaluation process.


To appraise the success of academic offering in accordance with students' expectations

To bring about the holistic development of a student's personality through social and spiritual dimensions




# STUDENTS' FEEDBACK ANALYSIS FOR THE YEAR 2021-22 UG PROGRAMME




The chart shows that majority 71 percent have stated that the depth of course content is excellent and 23 percent of the students have opined that the depth of the course is very good.




The chart depicts that majority 56 percent have stated that the extent of coverage of the course is excellent and 34 percent of the students have stated as very good.




The chart indicates that majority 56 percent have stated that the applicability /relevance of the course to real life situation is excellent and 32 percent of the students have opined as very good.




From the chart it could be identified that majority 55 percent have stated that the balance between theory and application is excellent and 32 percent of the students is of the opinion that it is very good.




From the chart it could be noted that majority 59 percent have given their opinion that the focus on skill development is excellent and 30 percent of the students have stated as very good.



The chart depicts that majority 60 percent have accepted that the coverage of basic and recent concepts is excellent and 29 percent of the students have stated as very good.




The chart indicates that majority 58 percent have stated that the extent of generating interest in subject area is excellent and 30 percent of the students have stated as very good.




Majority 65 percent of the students have given the overall rating as excellent, followed by 25percent giving the rating as very good.




The chart shows that majority 64 percent have stated that the depth of course content is excellent and 28 percent of the students have opined that the depth of the course is very good.




The chart depicts that majority 46 percent have stated that the extent of coverage of the course is excellent and 43 percent of the students have stated as very good.




The chart indicates that majority 53 percent have stated that the applicability /relevance of the course to real life situation is excellent and 33 percent of the students have opined as very good.




From the chart it could be identified that majority 49 percent have stated that the balance between theory and application is excellent and 38 percent of the students is of the opinion that it is very good .




From the chart it could be noted that majority 53 percent have given their opinion that the focus on skill development is excellent and 34 percent of the students have stated as very good.



The chart depicts that majority 54 percent have accepted that the coverage of basic and recent concepts is excellent and 34 percent of the students have stated as very good.






It is seen from the chart that 76.25% of the teachers found the course content in curriculum is excellent.




The chart implies that 60.83% teachers think learning value of the syllabus is excellent and 35% think it is very good, 4.17% think it is good.




The chart shows that majority 57 percent find module wise organisation of course is excellent and 35 percent of the teachers have opined that it is very good.




The chart depicts that majority 65 percent of teachers find the coverage of basic and recent concepts is excellent and 30.83 percent of the teachers have stated it as very good.




The chart indicates that majority 56.25 percent have stated that the scope for employability is excellent and 33.75 percent have stated it as very good.






From the chart it could be noted that majority 54.17 percent have stated that the focus on skill development is excellent and 39.58 percent of the teachers have stated it as very good.



The chart depicts that majority 60.83 percent have accepted that the credit and hours allotted for specific courses is excellent and 32.5 percent of the teachers have stated as very good.






It is seen from the chart that 73 Percent of the teachers found the course content in curriculum is excellent.




The chart implies that 52 Per cent teachers think learning value of the syllabus is excellent and 43 Percent think it is very good, 5 Percent think it is good.




The chart shows that 65 Percent majority percent find module wise organization of course is excellent and 32 percent of the teachers have opined that it is very good.




The chart depicts that majority 55 percent of teachers find the coverage of basic and recent concepts is excellent and 41 percent of the teachers have stated it as very good.




The chart indicates that majority 60 percent have stated that the scope for employability is excellent and 28 percent have stated it as very good.




From the chart it could be identified that majority 49 percent have stated that the scope for entrepreneurship is excellent and 35 percent of the teachers is of the opinion that it is very good.











Feedback analysis on curriculum frame work reveals that 76 per cent respondents gave excellent and 20 per cent gave very good.



From the alumni feedback, 73 percent stated that extent of syllabus content is excellent and 22 percent of the alumni have opined as very good.




It is seen from the chart for the parameter facilities for higher education and research that, the maximum 69 per cent retorts excellent and 21 per cent retorts very good.




Feedback analysis on scope for internship/ industrial visit/educational tour/project reveals that 58 per cent of the respondents gave excellent and 33 per cent gave very good.






Feedback analysis reveals that 45 per cent respondents gave excellent and 37 per cent gave very good for the parameter nurtures human values and culture.






Feedback analysis on curriculum frame work reveals that 75.90 per cent respondents gave excellent and 20.5 per cent gave very good.




From the alumni feedback, 69.90 percent stated that extent of syllabus content is excellent and 28.90 percent of the alumni have opined as very good.




It is seen from the chart for the parameter facilities for higher education and research that, the maximum 72.28 per cent retorts excellent and 20.50 per cent retorts very good.




Feedback analysis on scope for internship/ industrial visit/educational tour/project reveals that 51 per cent of the respondents gave excellent and 21 per cent gave very good.






Feedback analysis reveals that 67.47 per cent respondents gave excellent and 322.90 per cent gave very good for the parameter nurtures human values and culture.




The chart indicates that majority 63.86 percent have stated that the curriculum promotes skill development in excellent manner and 27.72 percent of the alumnae have opined as very good.




Alumni feedback reveals that 65 per cent sensed syllabus updating was excellent whereas 24 per cent gave very good on syllabus updation.
