Students Satisfaction Survey Report (2021-2022)

In order to have a comprehensive analysis of students learning outcomes for the academic session 2021-2022, a questionnaire of 36 parameters have been framed and forwarded online. The questionnaire of the survey included 36 questions to which responses were given anonymously by the students of the institution with the help of Google Forms. The survey components include an institute level feedback on infrastructure and learning experiences. Student Satisfaction Survey was conducted during the month of July 2022.



Totally 2338 students responded to Student Satisfaction Survey. The analysis of the survey conducted showed that, 1317 students were highly satisfied about the innovative teaching methodologies incorporated in the regular Teaching Learning Process of the institution. About 1550 students have expressed satisfaction over the regular schedule of seminars, assignments, internal tests and quiz conducted by various disciplines.



The parameters like promoting internships, field visit opportunities and effective mentoring process have also shown highly satisfactory responses from the students.


