

## Report of the IQAC review meeting

The following suggestions were made.

Members appreciated the activities of the IQAC during the academic years 2016-2017, 2017-2018 & 2018-2019. The activities were well documented and presented during the meeting.

In view of the forthcoming accreditation the following observations were made by the external members.

- ❖ The practice of feedback collected from all students, faculty, alumni, employer and parents is good.
- ❖ Usage of Solar panels as green campus initiatives is also commendable.
- ❖ The targets were to be fixed before the commencement of the academic year in alignment with NAAC and NIRF requirements. Also effective monitoring and evaluating mechanism must be devised.
- ❖ The curriculum revision has to be planned well in advance and must be quantified.
- ❖ Website must be revamped to a great extent to be the main source of information provider to all the stakeholders.
- ❖ Long term and short term strategic planning is required.
- ❖ 24 x 7 Learning management system to be introduced.
- ❖ Grievance redress mechanism to be strengthened.
- ❖ Academic council minutes, IQAC minutes has to be uploaded in the website.
- ❖ Online courses, SWAYAM courses can be integrated in the curriculum.
- ❖ Audit on Evaluation of manuscripts may be conducted periodically.
- ❖ FDP on plagiarism and IPR are to be carried out every year.
- ❖ Seed money may be provided for promotion of research.
- ❖ Policies to be formulated for research, consultancy, Infrastructure usage, Lab usage etc.
- ❖ Standard operating procedures and lab manuals must be prepared for Labs, mess/café etc.
- ❖ Campus company/Start ups concept must be promoted for example student co-operative stores.
- ❖ E-content prepared by the faculty may be uploaded in the college website.
- ❖ More amenities for Differently abled students.
